### **Tobacco Coordinator Update –**

The State dissolved the ITPC – the grant extends into June – more to follow at the next meeting. As of July 1, 8 million goes to Indiana state Dept of Health, they cut 9.5 million from the master settlement \$\$ cutting the top executive, hopefully the programs will stay.

All slot machines money from the race tracks will now go into the Master settlement \$\$ account.

Michelle attended a youth conference in Virginia on tobacco prevention – updates on dissolvable that she hopes to use.

The afternoon’s rock program completed with 17 and she is working on a head start hoping to educate parents.

### **Mini-Grant Submissions and reports:**

**Yearly Allocation: SV Middle school: \$1300.00.**

**1<sup>st</sup> Reading: Random Drug Testing: SVHS: \$225.00:** This money to be used for purchase drug screens for students caught with tobacco. Jennifer Smith works with High school students each week, each student must attend 3 sessions. This money will cover the last 3 groups.

**1<sup>st</sup> Reading: Drug Screen, Hamilton Center: \$3000.00.** Clients enrolled in Substance treatment will receive at least one screen at intake and during the course of treatment they will receive random screens. Note: HCI used 308 screens for the year and there was some money from 2010 grant used in the 1<sup>st</sup> 4 months of 2011.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: Vermillion Parke Community Health Center Counseling Services: \$4,000.00.**

Motion to reduce amount from \$5000.00 to \$4000.00 ½ from prevention and treatment, Note: Jane asked the center to keep track of the numbers separately for each category for the CCP.
